Club / Association, I will use my best endeavours to work within the following guidelines:

I will demonstrate good practice by:

- Treating all young people equally and with respect and dignity
- Always putting the welfare of each young person first, before winning or achieving goals
- Making sport enjoyable and promoting fair play
- Being an excellent role model this includes not smoking or drinking alcohol in the company of young people
- Giving enthusiastic and constructive feedback rather than negative criticism
- Keep up to date with the technical skills, qualifications and insurance in sport
- Maintaining a safe and appropriate distance with young persons in my charge
- Ensuring that if any form of physical contact is required, young people are consulted and their agreement gained
- Involve parents wherever possible, e.g. for the responsibility of their children in the changing room
- Securing parental consent in writing to act in loco parentis, if the need arises, to give permission for the administration of emergency first aid and/or other medical treatment
- Requesting written parental consent if I am required to transport young people in their cars
- Recognising the developmental needs and capacity of young people avoiding excessive training or competition and not pushing them against their will
- Building balanced relationships based on mutual trust which empower children to share in the decision-making process
- Always working in an open environment. Arrange that, as far as possible, I am not left alone with a young person where there is little or no opportunity for the activity to be observed by others
- Always having at least two adults present with a group
- Always ensuring appropriate ratios of leadership to children are observed according to age and gender
- Thinking about use of premises. For example do not expect children or young people to have to walk along a dark unsupervised path in order to access the toilets.



- Keeping a written record of each activity/session. This will include a register of children and staff and details of any significant incidents, including injuries that occur, along with the details of any treatment given
- Being aware of any medical conditions, existing injuries and medicines being taken.

I will avoid:

- Spending time alone with young people away from others
- Taking young people alone on car journeys however short
- Taking young people to your home.

I will never:

- Have an intimate relationship with a young person in your charge
- Engage in rough, physical or sexually provocative games, including horseplay
- Share a room with a young person in your charge
- Allow or engage in any form of inappropriate touching
- Allow young people to use inappropriate language unchallenged
- Make sexually suggestive comments to a young person, even in jest
- Do things of a personal nature for young people that they can do for themselves
- Invite or allow young people to stay with you at your home unsupervised
- Reduce children to tears as a form of control
- Refer to a child's ethnicity, disability, gender or sexuality in a way which is derogatory
- Allow allegations made by a child to go unrecorded or not acted upon.
